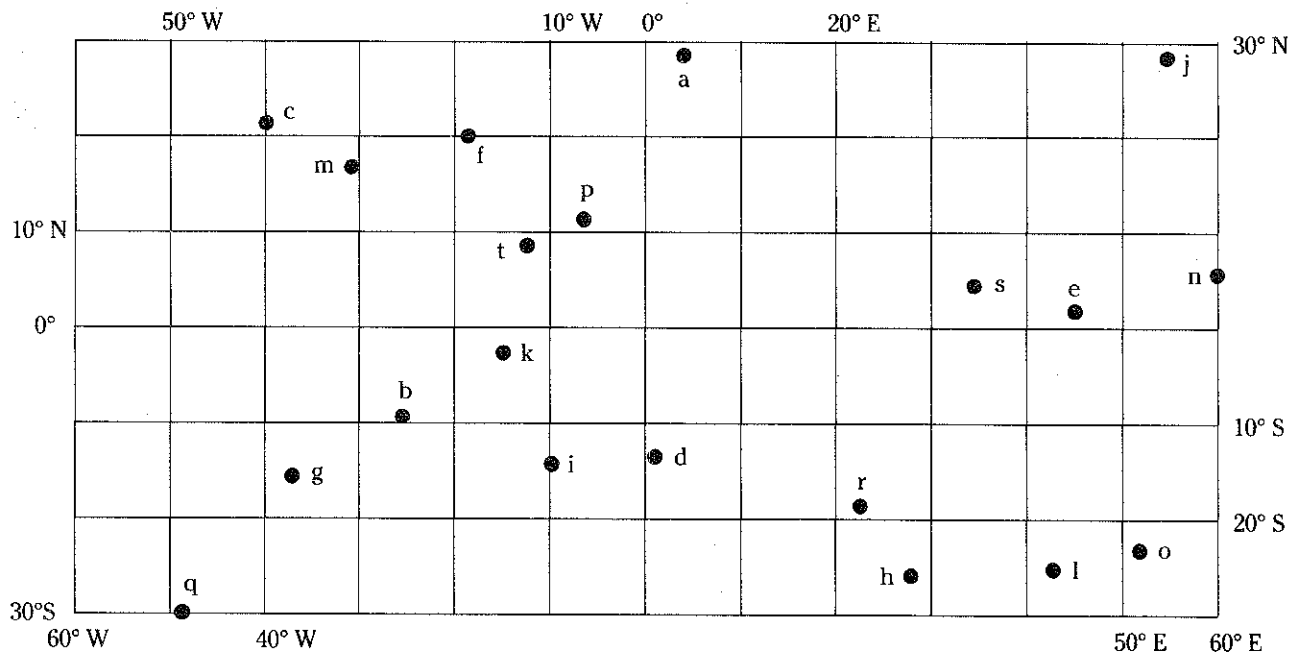


### Activity H: Between the Lines

If the parallels and meridians for all possible locations were drawn on maps, the maps would be covered solid with lines. Instead, a few parallels and meridians are placed at regular intervals, often of 10 or 15 degrees. *Estimating* degrees between these lines is required to locate most latitudes and longitudes. Use this activity to sharpen your estimating skills.
