Practice Dictionary Skills

Your text contains many words with which you may not be familiar. As you read, you will need to learn new terms and definitions. Checking vocabulary in a dictionary can help you understand the meanings of unfamiliar and difficult words. Dictionary entries provide a word's pronunciation, part of speech, different forms, origin, and definitions, as well as related words. The example below shows the types of information that you can learn from a dictionary about the word *stimulate*.

Word	Word Origin	First Part of Speech and Definition	Related Words
stimulate	Latin: <i>stimulus</i> goad	v. to excite to activity or growth or to greater activity	stimulation, stimulative, stimulator
