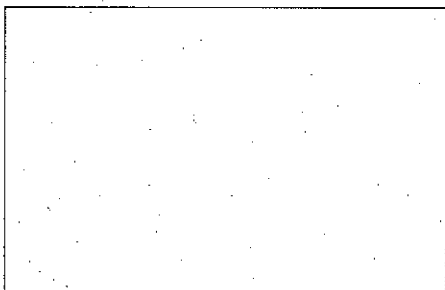

Visualize Meaning

As you read, you may form pictures in your mind. Building mental images of ideas and meanings is called visualizing. When studying, you may find it helpful to visualize the meanings of unfamiliar and difficult words. In this way, your imagination will help you make connections with and remember new vocabulary. The example below shows a possible visualization for *cash crop*.

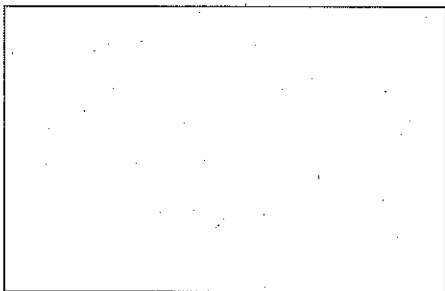
